

The Role of People in our School

Principal	<p>The Principal is the leader of our school. He oversees all parts of our school and works with everyone - students, teachers, parents and our community.</p> <p>The Principal makes sure that the students have the best opportunities possible and will ensure a safe environment for all.</p>
Deputy Principal	<p>Our school has 3 Deputy Principals. Each Deputy Principal looks after different areas of our school and reports back to the Principal. They help the Principal everyday and are there to offer support to students, teachers and parents.</p> <p>Each of our Deputies look after two year groups.</p>
Year Head	<p>Each year group has a Year Head and they are there to support each student.</p> <p>They work with students on areas such as wellbeing, educational and behavioural. They help create a positive environment for all students.</p>
Tutor	<p>Each class group will be assigned a tutor. You will meet your tutor each morning for 10-12 minutes. In the time, the tutor will call the roll, check journals/uniforms and chat/ discuss about any school information.</p> <p>Tutors are a very important point of contact for each student. If there is anything bothering a student, we advise each student to go to their tutor and they will support you and/or offer you advise. Tutors are part of our pastoral care support team.</p>
Prefects	<p>We have a number of different prefect roles in our school.</p>
1 st Year Prefects	<p>These are 6th Year students that are student leaders in our school. We have a Head Prefect and Deputy Head Prefect. We also have a number of different</p>

	<p>perfect roles such as - Arts & Culture, Sports, 1st Year, Inclusion to name a few.</p>
Mentors	<p>These are 6th Year students that support our 1st Year students. Each tutor group will have 4-5 mentors assigned to them. These mentors will work with you throughout the school year. They are there to offer support, answer questions, help with lockers and be a channel of advice for you.</p>
Guidance Counsellor	<p>We have 2 Guidance Counsellors in our school. They look after a number of different areas. They will help on areas such as exam preparation and study skills. They can also help with emotional and social support, where you are upset, feeling low, having friendships issues to name a few.</p> <p>Our guidance counsellors offer career guidance support to all our students.</p>
Chaplin	<p>Our School Chaplin supports the well-being and spiritual development of our students and the school community.</p> <p>Our School Chaplin will speak to students at their assembly each week. He leads/organises all our religious school ceremonies. He works closely with our Parish Priest Fr. Paul.</p> <p>Our School Chaplin also offers emotional and social support with our Guidance Counsellors.</p>
SENCO	<p>Our Special Educational Needs Co-Ordinator (SENCO) looks after any student with additional needs - learning, physical and behavioural. Our SENCO will coordinate learning support classes, offer advice and monitor student progress.</p> <p>Our SENCO offers support to students and works closely with all - students, teachers and parents.</p>
